Project Overview:

Following successful completion of the staff accommodation block, work began on new classrooms. With a bookstore and a hall divider, the structure is big enough to function as an exam hall when necessary. This saves pupils and their families time and money on exam day, and gives Bugondha some of the leading educational facilities in the area. The building's large size also warranted the construction of a 20,000 litre tank to harvest rainwater from the roof .
