Project Overview:

Andrew Billington kindly funded the construction of Kadungulu Secondary School's new dormitory and water tank. The structure provides safe, secure sleeping space for 40 of the institution's pupils, who would otherwise have to travel long distances to study. The nearby tank will harvest rainwater from the dormitory's large roof. This onsite water supply maximises learning time for pupils, who otherwise travel to the local borehole for water.
