

Great Hope Primary School VIP Latrine

Dec 2015 - March 2016







Project Overview:

A new latrine was built at Great
Hope for the students and staff. It sits
above a 25ft deep pit which is lined like a
water tank. The advantage of this is that
it can be emptied and refilled rather than
being single usel. This design expands
the lifetime of the structure and, thanks
to added ventilation, reduces unpleasant
odours. It also has an integrated urinal for
boys which diverts liquid waste from the
pit.
