

Kumel 2CRB with Central Meeting Space

Location: Kumel, Ngora

Partner: BuildAfrica

This was HYT's first project in partnership with BuildAfrica – the construction of a two-classroom block with a central meeting space. This project was part of a wider BuildAfrica initiative to improve schools across Ngora. The building is one of the largest HYT has ever constructed and is a bold statement of sustainable construction in the Teso region. Its innovative design is thanks to an ongoing partnership between HYT and the Richard Feilden Foundation. In addition to the classroom block, HYT constructed a 20,000L water tank and repaired an existing tank at the school, important in a region so prone to drought. Five trainees graduated, having learnt about ISSB construction technology. The structures are expected to improve the learning environment of Kumel P/S's 373 pupils.
